1. Minutes from May 19, 2005 were approved with one small change in wording.

2. The committee discussed the revised assessment plan from Area Five. The plan was approved, with some recommended changes and some discussion of implementation.

3. Other Business:

- Joe Law reported that he had discussed the GE Outcomes Evaluation form with CaTS. CaTS will keep the questions "Is this an honors section?" and "Is this a writing-intensive section?" CaTS will add a line on the cover sheet to be filled out by the staff or faculty member forwarding the completed forms to the college office. On this line the faculty member can indicate the actual status of the class
- Henry Limouze reported that PSY 105 and 110 had proposed new catalog descriptions and that these descriptions were approved by UCAPC. The new descriptions remove a problem with the older ones (which were identical for the two courses) and do not involve any substantive change in the course content.
- Henry Limouze will draft an introduction to the completed set of GE assessment plans. The committee will review this draft. The complete set of plans together with the introduction will be given to Tom Sav, chair of UCAPC, next week.
