SUBJECT: Student Immunization and Medical History Form

This is to inform you that Wright State University has a “Policy on International Student Immunization and Tuberculosis Screening.” **TUBERCULOSIS SCREENING IS REQUIRED TO BE REPEATED YEARLY.**

Required immunizations are: (written documents, including dates)

1. A recent Tetanus/diphtheria (Td) booster as an adult (within 10 years).
2. Mumps, Measles, Rubella (MMR) – two (2) doses: first injection after 12 months of age and a second injection prior to college arrival.
3. A negative Tuberculin MANTOUX Skin Test (TB/PPD), or a chest x-ray within the past 12 months. **TUBERCULIN SKIN TEST MUST BE READ IN MILLIMETERS (MM) BY A LICENSED PROFESSIONAL WITHIN 48-72 HOURS AFTER BEING ADMINISTERED. THE TEST IS REQUIRED TO BE REPEATED YEARLY.** If a student has a positive TB test, a chest x-ray report is needed from a physician.

A completed Student Immunization and Medical History Form must be returned to: Student Health Services, 051 Student Union, 3640 Colonel Glenn Hwy, Dayton OH 45435-0001, PRIOR to the first day of the quarter. Failure to submit a completed form will result in a “REGISTRATION HOLD” being placed upon your student account.
