***IMPORTANT INFORMATION AND DATES (read thoroughly)**

Due to changes in US State Department regulations, processing time for a passport is now nearly 6 months. If you do not have one, please apply for your passport as soon as possible to avoid any issues when it comes time for departure.

An initial refundable deposit of \$200 and program application is due no later than January 15, 2008. A second, non-refundable payment of \$500 is due by March 1, 2008. A final, non-refundable payment of \$900 is due by September 1, 2008. Wright State University Financial Aid is applicable to this program. Small study abroad scholarships are also available through the University Honors Program. Please make deposits and payments by check, payable to Wright State University.

Students with a 3.0 overall GPA or higher and Honors Program students in good standing are eligible for the program. All program participants must have completed at least the equivalent of Spanish 203 before our departure, with a GPA of at least 3.0 in Spanish courses taken.

January 7, 2008: First day to turn in applications and \$200 refundable deposits.

January 15, 2008: All applications and deposits due.

February 29, 2008: Last day to withdraw from program and have \$200 deposit refunded.

March 1, 2008: First program payment of \$500 due.

March 15, 2008: *Students must provide proof of having purchased airfare by this date.

September 1, 2008: Final program payment of \$900 due.

December 2, 2008: Departure to Costa Rica.**

December 22, 2008: Return to US

I have read all of the information about the 2008 Winter Ambassador Program to Costa Rica. I understand that I must purchase an airline ticket using the itinerary chosen by the Faculty Advisor by March 15, 2008, or I will lose my place in the program and be replaced with a student from the waiting list.
