**Shelley M. Jagow** Professor of Music at Wright State University serves as director of the Symphonic Band and Saxophone Quartet, and professor of Saxophone and Music Education courses.

Dr. Jagow serves as a Selmer Artist Clinician, performs with the Dayton Philharmonic Concert Band, Springfield Symphony Orchestra, Lebanon Symphony Orchestra, and has commissioned works for solo saxophone and ensembles from both national and international composers. She has presented clinics and performances at OMEA, MENC, ISME, and NASA conferences, and has served as honor band conductor at the local and provincial level.

She has published several articles in periodicals and is the author of the book and DVD of *Teaching Instrumental Music: Developing the Complete Band Program*.
