An Educational Articulation Agreement for the Transitioning of Associate Degree Nursing Students from Community Colleges to Wright State University's RN-to-BSN Program

Institutions & Degrees

- Wright State University (WSU): Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN)
- Edison Community College (ECC): Associate of Applied Science – Nursing (AAS-N)

Description

Students who complete an AAS-N degree at Edison Community College may transfer into the RN-to-BSN program at Wright State University. Students should verify their satisfactory academic progress (SAP) requirements with the financial aid office before pursuing classes outside of their AAS-N degree requirements.

Admission Requirements for RN-to BSN Program at WSU

- Successful completion of AAS-N at ECC
- Other required coursework
 - Completion of Ohio Transfer Module OR the following courses:
 - High School Chemistry OR WSU CHM 1010/ECC CHM 110S
 - Cultural Anthropology (WSU: ATH 2500/ECC:ANT 121 OR ANT 123)
 - Second English (WSU 2100/ECC 122S)
 - Pathophysiology (WSU: NUR3100)
 - Biology (WSU: BIO1050,1070,1120 OR 1150/ECC BIO 124S)
 - Developmental Psych (WSU 3410/ ECC 227S)
 - WSC History (WSU History- 3 credits/ ECC Choose from HST 125S OR HST 126S)
 - WSU Elective (WSU Elective- 3 credits/ECC Choose from HUM 121S, ART 123S, ART 124S, ENG 123S, ENG 221S, ENT 222S,MUS 120S, MUS 127S, PHI 121S, PHI 123S, REL 121S, REL 121S, THE 121S)
 - WSC Multicultural (WSC Multicultural- 3 credits/ECC Choose from GLG 121S, REL 121S, ENG 205S, HST 125 OR HST 126 if NOT taken to meet WSC History requirement above)
- Successful completion of NLN physical assessment achievement test OR WSU NUR 2150
- Successful completion of Pharmacology Test Out option OR WSU HLT 3400


