Proposed Minor in Communication Studies

I. Title of Program: Minor in Communication Studies*

Department: Communication

College: Liberal Arts

II. Objectives: The purpose of this minor is to serve students with multiple interests and diverse talents to enhance their communication skill to complement their major area of study. This minor will also help students who are interested in broadening their views and increasing their awareness of communication practices. This minor is designed for students who are not majors in communication.

III. Description (Catalog): The Communication Studies minor is designed to develop broadly trained students in the liberal arts. Students are encouraged to develop their abilities as effective communicators and as informed critical receivers. The Communication Studies minor affords students maximum freedom of choice in designing their programs of study and areas of specialization.

IV. Admission Requirements: Admission requirements are designed to be consistent with existing department requirements. These requirements are as follows:

1. Student must be an undergraduate and have junior status
2. Student must have admission in another degree program
3. Student must have completed 60 hours of coursework
4. Student must have a minimum GPA of 2.5

V. Program Requirements: The proposed minor is based on the major degree program; see above admissions requirements for minoring in Communication Studies.

VI. Program Quality: The proposed minor is based on the major degree program and the program quality is the same.

VII. Student Performance: Students must maintain a 2.0 and above.

VIII. Student Performance: Students must maintain a minimum 2.0 GPA.

IX. Curriculum Coordination: The proposed minor does not include new courses or require additional library resources. The courses are regularly taught by communication faculty.

X. Resource Coordination: The proposed minor is a packaging of existing courses that are regularly taught by communication faculty.

XI. Program Staffing: The proposed minor will be taught by current communication faculty.
