
Budget Overview Fiscal Year 2002

Revenues will grow more slowly in the next two years


 Tuition increases of six percent do not offset much slower growth in state support


WSU Revenues, 1999-2000, Net of Scholarships and Fellowships, in Millions

The state budget is still being debated

- Final legislative action is not expected until June 1
- The Ohio Supreme Court will determine whether K-12 education funding meets constitutional standards
- The university must remain ready to respond to further state budget changes

Budget Overview Fiscal Year 2002

Spending is growing faster than revenues

- Pay increases
- Health insurance costs
- University-funded scholarships and fellowships

Budget problem becomes more challenging in 2002-03

- State funding may be flat that year
- We have a year to prepare
- We must approach 2001-02 differently because of the more difficult year ahead


Budget Overview Fiscal Year 2002


Share of State Appropriations





State Share of Instruction Assumptions Fiscal Year 2002

- State Share of Instruction is calculated using the sum of three enrollment-driven pieces, based on the larger of the 2 or 5 year average of all-term FTE*
 - 1. Instruction and Support portion consists of the Cost Allowance minus the Fee Assumption.
 - 2. The Student Services Weight, which is a ratio of headcount to FTE to recognize that campuses with large parttime enrollments have higher student costs
 - 3. The greater of POM Activity Weight (which weights FTE enrollments for noncredit job training and for sponsored

There is a 100% prior year Hold Harmless Provision, ensuring no reduction in subsidy.

Main Campus

- was calculated using the average of the prior 2 years FTE
- was adjusted for the POM Activity Weight
- is anticipated to have a 2.61% increase over the FY 2001 budget
- FY 2002 doctoral State Share of Instruction is expected to decline due to decreasing doctoral enrollment and change in subsidy levels

Lake Campus

- was calculated using the average of the prior 2 years FTE
- was adjusted for the POM Activity Weight
- is anticipated to have a 15.6% increase over FY 2001 actual, due to changes in reporting class sections and increased enrollment

* All-terms FTE is calculated using the sum of student credit hours for all four quarters divided by 45. All FTE's are calculated by subsidy level by campus.

FY 2002 Enrollment Forecast Primary Assumptions

- No increase in Direct from High School Freshmen over last year based on additional campus housing applications and additional scholarships, but a 5% decrease in total Direct from High School applicants.
- No increase in Transfer students over last year based on a 0% increase in applications.
- A slight decrease in Main Campus Master's student credit hours based on a 1.5% increase in applications but a declining trend in enrollment.
- School of Professional Psychology changed to 5 year program resulting in 28 additional students.
- School of Medicine status quo.
- A decrease in Lake Campus Master's student credit hours.
- Special Sections based largely on FY 01 actual.
- Average credit hour loads continue to increase at both the graduate and undergraduate levels.





Budgeted Expenditures By Object - Unrestricted Fiscal Year 2002




Fee Revenue and Discount Fee Increase Fiscal Year 2002

WRIGHT STATE UNIVERSITY CURRENT FUNDS BUDGET 2001-2002 RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, enrollment levels are anticipated to remain relatively constant and state support is undecided, but is expected to grow more slowly than in prior years; and

WHEREAS, appropriate planning and consultation within the university has been accomplished; and

WHEREAS, Wright State University has developed a budget to guide operations during the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001; and

WHEREAS, said budget includes an array of Auxiliary Fees, Earnings Accounts and Other Rates and Fees, in addition to Instruction and General Fees; Therefore be it

RESOLVED that the President may make expenditures within projected income levels, may limit the expenditures of funds within any given category, may transfer funds within the major budget categories, and take such other actions, as may be in the best interest of the university; and be it further

RESOLVED that the university's current funds budget as described in the accompanying text and tables, including the Auxiliary Fees, Earnings Accounts and Other Rates and Fees, now before the Board of Trustees be and hereby are approved.
