For non-Ohio resident students, the out-of-state tuition is not guaranteed.

Inclusive Courseware Fee

Background

In an effort to protect students and insure their best interest, the U.S. Department of Education published new rules ([34CFR668.161-167](#)) via the Federal Register on October



30, 2015. The Program Integrity and Improvement rules require Wright State University to provide students the ability to opt out of fees charged to a student's account that are associated with books and/or online access to course materials.

Completing the Opt-Out Process
