

No-Show Policy in Campus Housing Terms and Conditions

As we quickly approach the start of a new academic year at Wright State University, we continue to work hard to prepare for your arrival to campus housing. Since we are reserving a housing assignment especially for you, it is critical that you notify us immediately if your plans have changed. You are currently responsible for your campus housing payment obligations, and so we wish to remind everyone of our campus housing No-Show Policy:

If you fail to move in to your housing assignment at the beginning of the Fall Semester 2020, and have not followed the appropriate procedures for obtaining a release from your housing agreement, and you are enrolled as a student of Wright State University you will be charged and will be responsible for paying all room fees (including room charges, communications fee and residential activity fee) for Fall Semester 2020 and for Spring Semester 2021 of your Residence Agreement. **Village Residents** are responsible for Fall Semester 2020, Spring Semester 2021 and Summer Semester 2021 of your Residence Agreement.
