- Depending on the associate degree requirements, some technical elective credits may be applicable toward General Education/Wright State Core requirements at Wright State, instead of Open Elective requirement.
- All students with declared organizational leadership major are automatically admitted as Pre-Organizational Leadership students.
- In order to be admitted fully as an organizational leadership major at Wright State, students will need to achieve a cumulative GPA of a 2.0.
- *Depending on the leadership and military studies courses (LMM) students receive on CCAF transcript, they may receive credits that satisfy OL 3010 or ENG 3000.
- Students may have a Joint Services Transcript (JST). Any military training, experience, and coursework listed on JST with American Council on Education (ACE) credit recommendations will receive credits toward Open Elective.
