

Criteria for Graduate Status for Aerospace Medicine

This means that, for all categories of graduate faculty membership, nominees must, at a minimum, satisfy *EITHER* items A, B, C, and D below (Regular), items A, B, C (Associate) *OR* item E below (Associate):

- A. an appropriate terminal degree for graduate instruction in the field;
- B. a demonstrated involvement in graduate instruction through teaching and, where applicable, graduate student supervision;
- C. a current (within the past seven years) and relevant record of scholarly or creative accomplishment through metrics such as research, publications, professional activities, and/or creative work (as appropriate to the field);

For regular faculty, they must meet A, B, C, but also

- D. rank of assistant professor or above in a degree-grant academic unit at Wright State University

OR

- E. Satisfy alternative criteria specific to the relevant discipline or course(s) as previously approved by the Graduate Faculty Membership Committee.

- 1. In Lieu of a Terminal degree – **Requires items a, b, and c below.**
 - a. An M.D. or D.O. degree
 - b. Board certification/eligibility after successful completion of an approved American Board of Medical Specialties (ABMS) residency program
 - c. Five or more years of combined experience practicing aerospace medicine, space medicine, aerospace toxicology, or case disposition/adjudication at the consultation/waiver level in a government or Department of Defense entity
- 2. Record of scholarship (**Requirement: At least 15 points in previous six years with at least one item from both categories A and B**)

Category A – Each item below is valued at 3 points for each year that it is applicable

- _____ 2. Peer or editorially reviewed article published in a recognized outlet
- _____ 3. Significant role with a private or governmental entity advising or providing clinical care in aerospace/space medicine

Category B - Each item below is valued at 1 point for each year that it is applicable

- ____ 1. Presentation at an academic or professional conference
- ____ 2. Panel participation at an academic or professional conference
- ____ 3. Discussant at an academic or professional conference
- ____ 4. Contribution to a book related to one's regular teaching field
- ____ 5. Reviewer of manuscripts for a conference
- ____ 6. Editor of a journal related to one's regular teaching field (repeated activity can only be counted once)
- ____ 7. Science or teaching conference coordinator
- ____ 8. Officer or member of a national or regional professional or teaching related group
- ____ 9. Member of a medical or professionally oriented board or committee
- ____ 10. Attendance at a related medical, science or academic professional conference related to one's teaching field
- ____ 11. Attendance at a presentation made by a clinician or recognized expert in the field of aerospace medicine about an academic or clinical topic
- ____ 12. Engage in coursework, training, or professional development relevant to one's teaching area
- ____ 13. Consulting
