Wright State University accepts College-Level Examination Program (CLEP) Subject Matter Tests listed in the above table. The guidelines that govern the application of transfer credit will be used to apply credit to degree requirements or students who score at or above designated minimums on College-Level Examination Program (CLEP) Subject Matter tests. The above minimum scores are based on recommendations from the Ohio Articulation and Transfer Network of the Ohio Department of Higher Education (ODHE).

Individual academic departments, in accordance with ODHE recommendations, have determined how CLEP credit is to be awarded. If the CLEP exam is the equivalent of a specific course, "Pass" or "CR" credit will be awarded for that class as shown above.

The above course equivalencies and credit hours will be awarded only to students whose courses have not already been evaluated at Wright State. Course equivalencies and credit hours are subject to change without notice and will be granted in accordance with those current when CLEP scores are evaluated.
