Social Work Baccalaureate Completion Program

Student who complete the associate degree in Social Work Assistant at Chatfield College may transfer into the bachelor's in Social Work at Wright State University. The Associate Degree at Chatfield consists of 39 hours in Core Course Requirements and a minimum of 30 hours in social sciences of which approximately 54 hours will count toward requirements toward the B.A. in Social Work at Wright State.

Admission Requirements to Pre-Social Work at Wright State

- 1. Cumulative GPA of 2.25
- 2. Grade of "C" or better in ENG 1100 equivalency
- 3. Two additional Arts/Humanities or Social Sciences

Additional Information

- All Liberal Arts B.A. majors at Wright State require 42 semester hours of credit at the 3000/4000 level.
