Nursing Baccalaureate Completion Program

Students who complete an Associate of Applied Science degree in Nursing at Cincinnati State Community College may transfer into the BSN Completion Program at Wright State University.

As part of the AAS-N degree, students should complete the following courses at Cincinnati State Community College:

BIO 151, BIO 152, PSY 110, ENG 101, ENG 102, BIO 220, COM 110, and SOC 105

In addition to the AAS-N degree, students may complete additional course work at Cincinnati State Community College that will apply to the BSN degree at Wright State. Appropriate courses are suggested in the concluding portion of this document. Students should verify their satisfactory academic progress (SAP) requirements with the financial aid office before pursuing classes outside of their AAS degree requirements.

Admission Requirements to the BSN Completion Program at Wright State

1. Active RN license
2. Both the BCI and FBI background checks are required for undergraduate students. The background check results must have no criminal history record on file.
3. Cumulative GPA of 2.0
4. Completion of the following prerequisite courses with an earned grade of C or better: English Composition I, English Composition II, Introductory Psychology, Pharmacology.

This agreement will expire two years from date of signature.
