



Psychology Transfer Program

Students who complete the A.A. degree at Cincinnati State Technical and Community College may transfer into the B.A. or B.S. in Psychology at Wright State University.

The *Associate of Arts* Degree at Cincinnati State consists of 61 total credit hours, distributed between the Ohio Transfer Module, First Year Experience course, Cooperative Education, and Electives. Students must earn an overall GPA of 2.0 in order to graduate with the AA degree.

Admission Requirements to Psychology major at Wright State

1. 15 semester hours earned
2. Complete introduction to psychology with grade of at least a C
3. Cumulative GPA of at least 2.25

Additional Information

- Students pursuing the B.S. in Psychology may choose an optional concentration in one of three areas: Behavioral Neuroscience, Cognition and Perception, or Industrial/Organizational Psychology.
