



Sign Language Interpreting Baccalaureate Completion Program

Student who complete the Associate’s degree in Interpreter Training Program at Cincinnati State Technical and Community College may transfer and use all, or almost all, of their credits toward the B.S. in Sign Language Interpreting at Wright State University.

Cincinnati State students may take additional courses beyond their associate degree in order to meet requirements for the Sign Language Interpreting degree. Students may complete the Ohio Transfer Module (OTM) before transferring in order to fulfill the Wright State general education program, called the Wright State Core. Consult a Cincinnati State advisor for more information. Students should verify their satisfactory academic progress (SAP) requirements with the financial aid office before pursuing classes outside of their associate degree.

Admission Requirements to Sign Language Interpreting major at Wright State

1. Completed Associate’s in Interpreter Training Program,
2. Cumulative GPA of 2.35, and
3. Interview with program faculty member.

Additional Information

- Student must complete a minimum of 30 semester hours of credit at Wright State to meet residency requirement.

This agreement will expire June 30, 2019. Please note, requirements are subject to change. Contact a Wright State advisor in your major at least once a year to verify current requirements.

**Cincinnati State's Interpreter Training Program,
to
Wright State's Sign Language Interpreter, B.S.**

The following required courses at Cincinnati State will count toward the Wright State Core, the general education program.

Wright State recognizes the completion of the Ohio Transfer Module as meeting the requirements for the Core Curriculum, regardless of course to course equivalencies.
