



Social Work Transfer Program

Student who complete the A.A. degree at Cincinnati State Technical and Community College may transfer into the B.A. in Social Work at Wright State University.

The *Associate of Arts Degree* at Cincinnati State consists of 61 total credit hours, distributed between the Ohio Transfer Module, First Year Experience course, Cooperative Education, and Electives. Students must earn an overall GPA of 2.0 in order to graduate with the AA degree.

Admission Requirements to Pre-Social Work at Wright State



1. Cumulative GPA of 2.25
2. Grade of "C" or better in ENG 1100 equivalency
3. Two additional Arts/Humanities or Social Sciences

Additional Information

- All Liberal Arts B.A. majors at Wright State require 42 semester hours of credit at the 3000/4000 level.
- All Liberal Arts B.A. majors at Wright State require a foreign language through the 2020 level.
- No more than 45 hours of course work in the major department will count toward the B.A. degree.
- A grade of "C" or better in all required Social Work courses.
