Students who complete an **Associates of Science (AS)** degree in **Business Administration** at Clark State Community College may transfer into any of the **Bachelor of Science in Business (BSB)** programs at Wright State University. Students should verify their satisfactory academic progress (SAP) requirements with the financial aid office before pursuing classes outside of their AS degree requirements.

**Majors:** Accountancy, Business Economics, Entrepreneurship, Finance, Financial Services, Human Resource Management, International Business, Management, Management Information Systems, Marketing, Supply Chain Management.


### Admission Requirements to Business Major Programs at Wright State


