



Social Work Transfer Program

Students who complete an Associate of Arts (AA) degree at Clark State Community College may transfer into the Bachelor of Arts (B.A.) in Liberal Arts with a major in Social Work at Wright State University. Students should verify their satisfactory academic progress (SAP) requirements with the financial aid office before pursuing classes outside of their AA degree requirements.

Admission Requirements to the Pre-Social Work Program at Wright State

1. Cumulative GPA of 2.25,
2. Grade of "C" or better in ENG 1100 equivalency, and
3. Two additional Arts/Humanities or Social Sciences.

Additional Information

- All Liberal Arts B.A. majors at Wright State must complete 42 semester hours of courses at the 3000/4000 level.
- All Liberal Arts B.A. majors at Wright State require a foreign language or American Sign Language (ASL) through the 2020 level.
- No more than 45 hours of course work in the major department will count toward the bachelor's degree.
- After admission to Wright State, students must apply and be accepted into the Social Work Program. Applications for admission to the SW major are due by February 1 preceding the fall term the student plans to begin the major. Those accepted during this time will start the social work program in the fall.

This agreement will expire two years from date of signature.
