



## English Transfer Program

Students who complete an **Associate of Arts (AA)** degree at Clark State Community College may transfer into the Bachelor of Arts (B.A.) in English at Wright State University. Students may choose a concentration in Creative Writing, Language Arts Education, Literature, Professional Writing, or Teaching English to Speakers of Other Languages (TESOL). Students should verify their satisfactory academic progress (SAP) requirements with the financial aid office before pursuing classes outside of their A.A. degree requirements.

### Admission Requirements to the English Program at Wright State

1. Earn at least a 2.0 cumulative GPA (or 2.5 for Language Arts Education)
2. Grade of "C" or better in ENG 1100 equivalency, and
3. Two additional Arts/Humanities or Social Sciences.
