



International Studies Transfer Program

Students who complete an Associate of Arts (AA) degree at Clark State Community College may transfer into the International Studies BA program at Wright State University. Students should verify their satisfactory academic progress (SAP) requirements with the financial aid office before pursuing classes outside of their associate degree requirements.

Admission Requirements to International Studies Program at Wright State

1. Cumulative GPA of 2.0,
2. Grade of "C" or better in ENG 1100 equivalency, and
3. Two additional Arts/Humanities or Social Sciences.

Additional Information

- All Liberal Arts B.A. and B.S. majors at Wright State must complete 42 semester hours of courses at the 3000/4000 level.
- No more than 45 hours of course work in the major department will be counted toward the bachelor's degree.
