Organizational Leadership

Students who complete an associate degree at Clark State Community College may transfer into the B.S. in Organizational Leadership at Wright State University. By completing an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree, students will have completed the Ohio Transfer Module and thus have met the general requirements of the Wright State Core as long as they have taken the required Microeconomics and Statistics. Students graduating with an applied degree, i.e., Associate of Applied Business, Associate of Applied Science, or Associate of Technical Studies, may need to complete additional Transfer Module courses.

If possible, students should complete the following courses at Clark State:

1. ECO 2220, Microeconomics
2. STT 2640, Elementary Statistics

Admission Requirements to the Organizational Leadership Program at Wright State





1. Associate's degree earned (A.A., A.S., A.A.B., A.A.S., or A.T.S.)

or

1. 60 semester credits earned,
2. Cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher, and
3. Complete STT 2640 (Elementary Statistics), OL 2010 (Self as Leader), and OL 3020 (Leading Others); these OL courses are not available at Clark State and must be taken at Wright State University.
