Students who complete an Associate of Arts (AA) degree at Clark State Community College may transfer into the **Psychology, B.A.** or **Psychology, B.S.** program at Wright State University. Students should verify their satisfactory academic progress (SAP) requirements with the financial aid office before pursuing classes outside of their associate degree requirements.

Admission Requirements to Psychology Program at Wright State

1. 15 semester hours earned
2. Complete introduction to psychology with grade of at least a C
3. Cumulative GPA of at least 2.25
