



Sign Language Interpreting Baccalaureate Completion Program

Students who complete an AAS degree in Interpreter Education at Columbus State Community College may transfer into the Sign Language Interpreting B.S. program at Wright State University.

Columbus State students may take additional courses beyond their associate degree in order to meet requirements for the Sign Language Interpreting degree. Students may complete the Ohio Transfer Module (OTM) before transferring in order to fulfill the Wright State general education program, called the Wright State Core. Consult a Columbus State advisor for more information. Students should verify their satisfactory academic progress (SAP) requirements with the financial aid office before pursuing classes outside of their associate degree.

Admission Requirements to Sign Language Interpreting major at Wright State

1. Completion of AAS degree in American Sign Language Interpreting for the Deaf,
2. Cumulative GPA of 2.35 or higher, and
3. Interview with program faculty member.

Additional Information

- Student must complete a minimum of 30 semester hours of credit at Wright State to meet residency requirement.
