Being unable to obtain proof means that it has been 10 days since you have requested the transcript and the IRS has yet to respond to your request.

I also certify that it has been 10 days since I have attempted both of the following methods to obtain the Verification of Nonfiling transcript from the IRS and I have not been able to get it:

- ✓ I attempted to obtain the Nonfiling transcript by using the “Get Transcript Online” option on the IRS website.
- and
- ✓ I requested the Nonfiling transcript by using the IRS 4506-T form online or by mail, it has been 10 days since my request, and the IRS has not sent the requested transcript.

Note: It takes 7-10 business days to receive transcript requests from the IRS by mail.

- ✓ I listed all employers on the Verification Worksheet and provided copies of my 2020 W-2s.
