



Criminal Justice Transfer Program

Students who complete an **A.A.S. degree** in Criminal Justice at Edison Community College may transfer into the Crime and Justice Studies B.A. programs at Wright State University. Students should verify their satisfactory academic progress (SAP) requirements with the financial aid office before pursuing classes outside of their associate degree requirements.

Admission Requirements to the Crime and Justice Program at Wright State

1. Earn at least a 2.5 cumulative GPA,
2. Grade of "C" or higher in ENG 1100 equivalency
3. Two additional general education Arts/Humanities and/or Social Sciences

Additional Information

- All Liberal Arts B.A. majors at Wright State require 42 semester hours of credit at the 3000/4000 level.
- Crime and Justice Studies (CJS) majors must take a minimum of 50% (22.5 hours) of criminal justice courses at Wright State.
- All Liberal Arts B.A. majors at Wright State require a foreign language through the 2020 level.
- No more than 45 hours of course work in the major department will count toward the B.A. degree.
