



## English Transfer Program

Students who complete an **A.A. degree** in English at Edison State Community College may transfer into the English B.A. programs at Wright State University. Students may choose a concentration in Creative Writing, Language Arts Education, Literature, Professional Writing, or Teaching English to Speakers of Other Languages (TESOL). Students should verify their satisfactory academic progress (SAP) requirements with the financial aid office before pursuing classes outside of their associate degree requirements.

If possible students should complete at least the first year of a foreign language while at Edison. Students can choose from:

- ASL 121S, 122S, (second-year ASL taken at Wright State) or
- FRN 121S, 122S, 221S, 222S, or
- GER 121S, 122S, 221S, 222S, or
- SPN 121S, 122S, 221S, 222S

### Admission Requirements to the English Program at Wright State

1. Earn at least a 2.0 cumulative GPA (or 2.5 for Language Arts Education),
2. Grade of "C" or higher in ENG 1100 equivalency, and
3. Two additional general education Arts/Humanities and/or Social Sciences.

### Additional Information

- All Liberal Arts B.A. majors at Wright State require 42 semester hours of credit at the 3000/4000 level.
- All Liberal Arts B.A. majors at Wright State require a foreign language through the 2020 level.
- No more than 45 hours of course work in the major department will count toward the B.A. degree.
