



## Social Work Transfer Program

Students who complete an **A.A.S. in Social Services** at Edison Community College may transfer into the Social Work, B.A. program at Wright State University. Students should verify their satisfactory academic progress (SAP) requirements with the financial aid office before pursuing classes outside of their associate degree requirements.

### Admission Requirements to Social Work at Wright State

1. Cumulative GPA of 2.25
2. Grade of C or higher in ENG 1100 and ENG 2100 equivalency,
3. Grade of C or higher in SW 2700, 2710, and 2720 equivalencies, and
4. Official application to the Social Work major by February 1 ([liberal-arts.wright.edu/social-work/advising/admission](http://liberal-arts.wright.edu/social-work/advising/admission)), and
5. In order to start the social work major in the Fall following admission, students must complete the following courses and/or their equivalencies with a D or better: BIO 1050 or BIO 1070; SOC 2000; PLS 2000 or PLS 2120; ECON 2000 or ECON 2900; COM 2020; and PSY 1010.

### Additional Information

- All Liberal Arts B.A. majors at Wright State require 42 semester hours of credit at the 3000/4000 level.
- All Liberal Arts B.A. majors at Wright State require a foreign language through the 2020 level.
- No more than 45 hours of course work in the major department will count toward the B.A. degree.
