**Edison State Community College to Wright State University**  
**Completion Program**

Students at **Edison State Community College** should complete the following courses in preparation for transfer to Wright State University to pursue the BS Ed in Sports Science. See the articulation chart on page two of this agreement for a detailed list of courses required for the BS Ed in Sports Science at Wright State University.

Students are encouraged to complete the **Ohio Transfer Module** while at Edison State Community College. The following courses should be taken as part of the Ohio Transfer Module in order to meet specific general education requirements for the BS Ed in Sports Science.

**BIO 125S and 126S Anatomy & Physiology I and II**  
**CHM 111S Basic Chemistry of Life Processes**

Currently, there is no associate degree program that aligns with the BS Ed in Sports Science.

**Admission into the BS Ed in Sports Science**

Students applying for admission to the university may be admitted to pre-major status in order to begin appropriate coursework while completing the process for full program admissions. Admission into pre-major status requires a 2.5 or better cumulative GPA.

The Sports Science program admits new students one time per year. All application materials must be submitted by March 1<sup>st</sup> to be admitted into the program for fall semester of that year.
