Exploring & Undecided Majors

Advisors in our Career Center and University College provide information on exploring majors and careers.

College of Education and Human Services (CEHS)—An Overview

Tips from Current Transfer Students on How to Be Successful

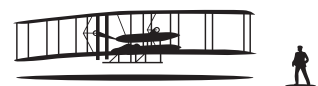

How to Maximize Earning College Credits While Still in High School

This session is for students who are considering or currently earning college credits in high school. In this session, you will learn the difference between credits that "transfer" and credits that "apply" to a degree, how to select the optimum courses that might advance your progress toward a college degree, and how and when to communicate what transfer credits you have earned (including College Credit Plus, Advanced Placement, and International Baccalaureate). We will also cover course registration and the orientation process for students who have participated in the College Credit Plus program.
