

**Honorary Resolution 14-12:
A Resolution Honoring Adrian Hill, the Veterans Voices Project, and the Veteran
and Military Center**

1 **WHEREAS,** Adrian D. Hill, junior in Social Sciences Education, served his nation in the
2 United States Army Reserve, was recently appointed by Governor John R.
3 Kasich to the Ohio Commission on Service and Volunteerism, and is the
4 Coordinator for the WSU Veterans Voices Project; and

5 **WHEREAS,** Veterans Voices, which was founded in 2014 as a class instructed by Bridgett
6 Federspiel, is a part of the national project known as Veterans History
7 Project, which was founded by an act of Congress in 2000; and

8 **WHEREAS,** Veteran Voices is a combined effort by Wright State University's Veteran
9 and Military Center, under the direction of Dr. Seth Gordon, and local
10 National Public Radio (NPR) station WYSO to record video interviews of
11 Veterans ranging from World War II to current conflicts in the Middle East;

13 **WHEREAS,** These interviews are then stored in both the Library of Congress and the
14 Wright State University Archives, where a total of 17 interviews have been
15 conducted, with 9 having been sent to the Library of Congress; now,
16 therefore, be it

17 **RESOLVED,** That the Student Government here assembled at Wright State University
18 commend Mr. Adrian D. Hill, the Veterans Voices Project, and the Veteran
19 and Military Center for all that they have done to further the support to
20 Veterans, and by extension, the greater community; and, be it

21 **FURTHER RESOLVED,** That the Wright State University Student Government
22 recognizes all Veterans at Wright State University and join the nation in
23 paying tribute to Veterans Day on 11th of November, 2014.
