

Graduate Faculty Qualifications Criteria

Alternate Criteria for MBA 5400

Person needs to meet all the criteria below:

- 1. Juris Doctorate from an American Bar Association accredited Law School. (No equivalence)
- 2. A minimum of two (2) years within the previous five years in government, private, or business practice, or teaching, research or consulting experience among these areas of law:
 - a. Contract
 - b. Tort
 - c. property (including real or intellectual)
 - d. Commercial law, including Uniform Commercial Code Article 2 (Sale of Goods) and UCC Article 9 (Secured Transactions)
 - e. Business associations, formation and taxation
- 3. Otherwise qualified under Instructional Professional standards (AACSB as currently adopted by RSCOB and incorporated by reference) with a minimum of three activities within the previous five years such as:
 - a. Ongoing professional experience in a field related to one's regular teaching field
 - b. Director for a business or professionally oriented board
 - c. Acquisition or maintenance of professional certification
 - d. Development or presentation of CPE or executive education courses
 - e. Consulting
 - f. Article published in a recognized outlet
 - g. Publication of a book related to one's regular teaching field
 - h. Significant role with a business enterprise
 - i. Similar professional related activities
