#### Alternate Criteria for MGT 7720, Project Contract Management

Person needs to meet all the criteria below:

- 1. Master's degree in Business or Juris Doctorate
- 2. A minimum of three years' experience within the past five years in project management environments, or teaching, research or consulting experience, including but not limited to these areas:
  - a. Contract formulation across the procurement cycle, from requirements definition to contract closeout
  - b. Contract negotiation, especially in support of project management
  - c. Conflict resolution, in areas such as mediation, arbitration, or alternative dispute resolution
  - d. Subcontractor management, in support of projects
  - e. Other appropriate areas included: \_\_\_\_\_
- 3. Otherwise qualified under Instructional Professional standards (AACSB as currently adopted by RSCOB and incorporated by reference) with a minimum of three activities listed below within the previous three years:
  - a. Member of a business or professionally oriented board closely related to the field of contract management
  - b. Acquisition or maintenance of relevant professional certification or warrants
  - c. Development, presentation, or completion of continuing professional education courses in the field contract management
  - d. Consulting or publication in areas relevant to contracting, negotiation, and conflict resolution
  - e. Significant role within a project-oriented enterprise
  - f. Similar professional related activities
