What is not recommended:

Chromebooks, Linux OS, mobile devices, and iPads are NOT recommended for students to use as their primary device. Certain programs for classes (testing software, plug-ins, etc.) will not work on these platforms. We strongly recommend that you buy or bring a Windows PC (Windows 10) or Apple Mac device (Mac OS 10.14 or higher) to be used for school.

Certain departmental requirements may necessitate different specifications. You are encouraged to contact your primary college to address any concerns you may have about departmental needs.
