

**Proposed Alternative Criteria for Associate Graduate Faculty Membership
Department of Modern Languages, French & Spanish**

For faculty who do not satisfy one or more of the criteria a, b, or c in Policy 2160.3, the Modern Languages (ML) graduate faculty have developed the following alternative criteria to evaluate nominees for Associate Graduate Faculty status for the French and Spanish Graduate Certificate Programs. These criteria will replace (a), (b), or (c) in the first paragraph of Policy 2160.3.

- I. In order to teach the following oral, aural, and written expression-based courses:
FR 5110 French Conversation & Culture;
FR 5120 French Conversation & Society;
FR 5210 Writing in French;
FR 5220 Advanced Writing in French;
SPN 5110 Conversation in Spanish;
SPN 5120 Advanced Conversation in Spanish;
SPN 5210 Writing in Spanish,
faculty must satisfy the criteria listed below:
- a. A Master's degree in French, Spanish, Linguistics or a related field
 - b. A minimum of 18 graduate credit hours beyond the Masters; one refereed publication or two professional conference presentations may be considered the equivalent of one graduate class. Applicable graduate courses or publications and/or conferences include:

 - c. Native or Superior speaker of French or Spanish (Oral Proficiency and Writing; Proficiency scores certified by the American Council on the Teaching of Foreign Languages (ACTFL) would be required for non-native speakers)
 - d. A minimum of two years of college language teaching experience at the upper level (target language courses beyond the required course sequence 1010-2020)

- II. In order to teach FR 5250 Business French or SPN 5250 Business Spanish, faculty must satisfy the criteria listed below:
- a. A Master's degree in French, Spanish, or a related field
 - b. An MBA and/or a minimum of two-years work experience in a target-language business career

- c. Native or ACTFL certified Superior speaker of French or Spanish (Oral Proficiency and Writing Proficiency scores certified by the American Council

on the Teaching of Foreign Languages (ACTFL) would be required for non-native speakers)

- d. A minimum of two years of college language teaching experience at the upper level (target language courses beyond the required course sequence 1010-2020)

III. In order to teach FR 5610 French Phonetics, faculty must satisfy the criteria listed below:

- a. A specialized Master's degree in linguistics, translation, or philosophy
- b. Native or ACTFL certified Superior Speaker of French or Spanish (Oral Proficiency and Writing Proficiency scores certified by the American Council on the Teaching of Foreign Languages (ACTFL) would be required for non-native speakers)
- a. A minimum of 18 graduate credit hours in the discipline beyond the Master's; one refereed publication or two professional conference presentations may be considered the equivalent of one graduate class. Applicable graduate courses or publications and/or conferences include:

- c. Native or ACTFL certified Superior Speaker of Spanish (Oral Proficiency and Writing Proficiency scores certified by the American Council on the Teaching of Foreign Languages (ACTFL) would be required for non-native speakers)
- d. A minimum of two years of college language teaching experience at the upper level (target language courses beyond the required course sequence 1010-2020)
