## SERVICES AT A GLANCE



### ACADEMIC SUPPORT SERVICES

- Testing accommodations:
  - Extended test time
  - Testing environment with reduced distractions
  - Assistive technology & software
  - Proctors for reading/writing
- Reader/writer services (in class)
- Classroom accommodations & laboratory assistance

### ALTERNATIVE FORMAT CONVERSION

- Textbooks & classroom materials converted to alternative formats:
  - Braille, PDF, Word documents, & tactile image enhancements

### ASSISTIVE TECHNOLOGY

- Dedicated computer lab with assistive technology in 034 LX (maintained by CaTS)
- Consultation & troubleshooting for assistive technology
- Consultation on universal design, accessible lab development, & distance learning

### AUTISM SPECTRUM SUPPORT

- Peer support group for students on autism spectrum (facilitated by licensed psychologist)
- Transition coaching program: Raiders on the Autism Spectrum Excelling (RASE)\*

### CAREER & VOCATIONAL SERVICES

- Professional development, career planning, & resume assistance
- Assistance with search for internships, co-ops, volunteer sites, career employment, etc.
- Recommendations for work-site accommodations

### DEAF & HARD OF HEARING SERVICES

- American Sign Language interpreters & C-Print live captioning
- FM/IR amplification systems

### PERSONAL ASSISTANCE

- On-campus personal assistance program for students with physical disabilities
  - Individual assistance with daily activities, such as personal hygiene, meals, laundry, etc.\*
  - Emergency P.A. response during nights & weekends\*
- Personal Assistance Station (072 Student Union) open to students for **free** assistance during academic terms (contact ODS for hours)

### ASSESSMENT SERVICES

- Psychoeducational & psychological evaluations\*
- Consults & collaborates with ODS to ensure implementation of appropriate academic services
