What Went Well

- Reported engagement with all students demonstrating and guiding
- Documents sharing

- Easier engagement vs. usual classroom set-up
- Intutitive to use
- Audio or oratory
- Size sufficient

- Authentication
- Room dimensions
- Teams chat function
- Whiteboard experience currently different across devices
- Teams functionality (Teams Classes)
- Pen/stylus
- Surface Hub and classroom computer
- External devices

- Working on better integration with classroom projection system
- Continue to support the ones we have as experimental
- Some departments have purchased on their own or are considering purchasing
- Future possibility of more integration as product develops
