#### **Assessment Feedback:**

All the interested parties received the Aqua results and this report via email.

Although there is room for improvement in student performance in both sections, the difference between the sections is within a range of .72. Although the instructors will be interested to see these results and will likely emphasize the importance of content development as well as sources and evidence, there is no planned change to the course based on this assessment.

We do recommend a revision of the rubric to add clarity, as there was some uncertainty over how to distinguish between some of the criteria in the rubric. It might also be helpful to have the same people assess both sections of the course next time, to ensure consistency.

One of us also pointed out that the three Core Learning Outcomes could be better differentiated, as there is a lot of overlap between them.

The assessment results have been shared with the department curriculum committee.

### **Assessment Administration Feedback**

The assessment of the courses was part of the Core assessment cycle. The assessment plan was reviewed and approved by the UCOC. The UCOC provided a presentation on tools available to assist with the assessment, including Watermark Aqua.
