Exploring & Undecided Majors

College of Education and Human Services (CEHS)—An Overview

Are you Earning College Credit While Still in High School?

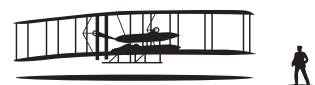
