Students who complete an **Associate of Science (A.S.) degree** (Business Concentration) at Rhodes State College may transfer into the Business B.S.B. program at Wright State University. Students should verify their satisfactory academic progress (SAP) requirements with the financial aid office before pursuing classes outside of their AS degree requirements.
