



English Transfer Program

Students who complete an **Associate of Arts (A.A.) English Writing/Literature Concentration** degree at Rhodes State College may transfer into the Bachelor of Arts (B.A.) in English at Wright State University. Students may choose a concentration in Creative Writing, Language Arts Education, Literature (can be completed at Dayton Campus or Lake Campus), and Professional Writing, or Teaching English to Speakers of Other Languages (TESOL). Students should verify their satisfactory academic progress (SAP) requirements with the financial aid office before pursuing classes outside of their AA degree requirements.

Admission Requirements to the English Program at Wright State

1. Earn at least a 2.0 cumulative GPA (or 2.5 for Language Arts Education).
2. Grade of "C" or higher in ENG 1100 equivalency (COM 1110 at Rhodes State)
3. Two additional Arts/Humanities and/or Social Sciences

Additional Information

- All Liberal Arts B.A. majors at Wright State require 42 semester hours of credit at the 3000/4000 level.
- All Liberal Arts B.A. majors at Wright State require a foreign language through the 2020 level.
- No more than 45 hours of course work in the major department will count toward the B.A. degree.
