



Organizational Leadership Baccalaureate Completion Program

Students who complete an associate degree at Rhodes State College may transfer into the B.S. in Organizational Leadership at either Wright State University's Dayton Campus or Lake Campus. Students graduating with an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree will have completed the Ohio Transfer Module and thus have met the general education requirements of the Wright State Core as long as they have taken the required Microeconomics and Statistics listed below. Students graduating with an applied degree will have to complete additional general education courses to complete the Wright State Core.

If possible, students should complete the following courses at Rhode State:

1. ECN 1430, Microeconomics (Equivalent to EC 2040)
2. MTH 1260, Elementary Statistics (Substitute for STT 1600.)

Admission Requirements to the Organizational Leadership Program at Wright State

1. Associate's degree earned
- or**
1. 60 semester credits earned
 2. Cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher
 3. Complete STT 1600 (or equivalent), OL 2010 and OL 3020

Residency Requirements

1. A minimum of 30 credit hours earned at Wright State
2. At least 10 of the last 30 hours earned at Wright State
3. A minimum of 20 hours of courses numbered 3000 or above earned at Wright State
