



Psychology Transfer Program

Students who complete an **Associate of Science (AS) in Psychology degree** at Rhodes State College may transfer into the Bachelor of Science (B.S.) or the Bachelor of Arts (B.A.) in Psychology programs at Wright State University.

In addition to the A.A. degree, students may complete additional coursework at Rhodes State to apply to the B.S. or B.A. in Psychology at Wright State. Appropriate courses are suggested in the concluding program portion of this document. Students should verify their satisfactory academic progress (SAP) requirements with the financial aid office before pursuing classes outside of their AA degree requirements.

Admission Requirements to the Psychology Program at Wright State

1. 15 semester hours earned
2. Complete introduction to psychology with grade of at least a C
3. Cumulative GPA of at least 2.25
