Students who complete an Associate of Arts (AA) Sociology Concentration degree at Rhodes State College may transfer into the Bachelor of Arts (B.A.) in Sociology at Wright State University. Students should verify their satisfactory academic progress (SAP) requirements with the financial aid office before pursuing classes outside of their AA degree requirements.

Admission Requirements to the Sociology Program at Wright State

1. Earn at least a 2.0 cumulative GPA,
2. Grade of "C" or higher in ENG 1100 equivalency, and
3. Two additional general education Arts/Humanities and/or Social Sciences.

Additional Information

- All Liberal Arts B.A. majors at Wright State require 42 semester hours of credit at the 3000/4000 level.
- All Liberal Arts B.A. majors at Wright State require a foreign language through the 2020 level.
- No more than 45 hours of course work in the major department will count toward the B.A. degree.
