1.	International students who are considered full-time registered students (12 or more undergraduate credit hours; 6 or more graduate credit hours) by the Registrar's Office for any semester, may <u>never</u> exceed 20 on-campus work hours.		
2.	International students may work a maximum of 28 hours per week during breaks between semesters if they are pre-registered at least half-time (6 undergraduate credit hours; 3 graduate credit hours) for the semester that immediately follows the break.		
3.	International students may work a maximum of 28 hours per week during Summer semester if they are registered for at least half-time (a minimum of 6 undergraduate; 3 graduate credit hours for Summer semester OR 0 credit hours for Summer semester but registered for at least half-time time for Fall semester.		
4.	On campus work hours are a combination of hours worked for <u>all</u> positions at Wright State University. Graduate students can NOT hold a graduate assistantship <u>and</u> a student employment position at the same time.		
5.	Pirect deposit into a checking or saving account at the financial institution of my choice is requested.		
6.	Any restrictions regarding my employment (i.e., visa status, scholarships, etc.) supersedes any of the above listed policies.		
7.	To determine if a tax treaty between your country and the U.S. Government exists, consult Table 2 in Publication 901, http://www.irs.gov/publications/p901/ar02.html#d0e189 To claim an exemption from U.S. Income Tax under a treaty, you MUST complete Form 8233 at Wright State University Payroll, 301 University Hall.
