Spring 2017 Open Seats Report

I. Constitutional and Executive Committee provisions

Article III Section 3.A.1

Elected faculty; one (1) from each constituency for every 30 fully-affiliated faculty or fraction thereof;

Article II Section 1 & 1.A

The University Faculty shall be comprised of persons who hold the following academic ranks within the university: university professor, professor, associate professor, assistant professor, senior lecturer, lecturer, instructor or clinical assistant professor and clinical instructor in the College of Nursing and Health.

A. A member of the University Faculty shall be considered fully-affiliated with Wright State University if:

1. The person is under full-time contract with the university requiring a majority of the member's professional efforts; and
2. The contractual obligation to Wright State University has first call on the person's time and effort; or
3. The person is on a tenure track or is fully-affiliated as defined by their contract.

Executive Committee Eligibility Ruling (3/17/2014)

The committee reviewed the constitutional requirements for fully-affiliated status and Senate eligibility and then made the following rulings:

- Human Resources full-time designation of 75%+FTE will be used to determine if a faculty member satisfies the full-time requirements of Faculty Constitution Article II Section I.
- Human Resources reported college designation shall be used to determine constituency membership for the requirements of the Faculty Constitution:
 - In cases where constituency membership isn't clear, the primary funding organization should be considered as the constituency.
 - The Executive Committee, on a case-by-case basis, will assign University College faculty to an appropriate constituency.

Note:

While excluded from serving on the Senate, Dean-ranks with a valid academic rank are counted for the purposes of determining the number of Senate seats since they fulfill the requirements of fully-affiliated faculty.

All colleges had a reduction in total faculty from this point last year.

CECS went above the threshold and gained a fourth seat last year. This year they have gone back below the threshold. Due to the timing of this reduction and the term-limits of the current CECS Senators, CECS does not have any open seats and will not require an election.
