Students who complete an Associate of Arts in Communication Studies at Sinclair College may transfer into the Bachelor of Arts in Communication Studies at Wright State University. Students should verify their satisfactory academic progress (SAP) requirements with the financial aid office before pursuing classes outside of their AA.

Admission Requirements to the Communication Studies Program at Wright State

1. Cumulative GPA of 2.5
2. Grade of "C" or better in ENG 1100 equivalency (*Sinclair's ENG 1101*)
3. Two additional Arts/Humanities or Social Sciences

Additional Information

- All Liberal Arts B.A. majors at Wright State must complete 42 semester hours of courses at the 3000/4000 level.
- All Liberal Arts B.A. majors at Wright State require a foreign language through the 2020 level. If possible, students should take the entire two-year language sequence at Sinclair.
- No more than 45 hours of course work in the major department will be counted toward the degree.

This agreement will expire June 30, 2019. Please note, requirements are subject to change. Contact a Wright State advisor in your major at least once a year to verify current requirements.
