



English Baccalaureate Completion Program Integrated Language Arts Concentration

Students who complete an **Associate of Arts** degree in English at Sinclair Community College may transfer into the **English, B.A.** program at Wright State University. Students should verify their satisfactory academic progress (SAP) requirements with the financial aid office before pursuing classes outside of their AS.

If possible, students should complete the entire two-year language sequence at Sinclair. Students may choose from:

- ASL 1111, 1112, 1228, and 1229
- FRE 1101, 1102, 2201, and 2202
- GER 1101, 1102, 2201, and 2202
- SPA 1101, 1102, 2201, and 2202

Admission Requirements to the English Program at Wright State

1. Cumulative GPA of 2.0
2. Grade of "C" or better in ENG 1100 equivalency (ENG 1101 at Sinclair)
3. Two additional Arts/Humanities or Social Sciences

Additional Information

- All Liberal Arts B.A. and B.S. majors at Wright State must complete 42 semester hours of courses at the 3000/4000 level.
- All Liberal Arts B.A. majors at Wright State must complete a foreign language through 2020 level of one language.
- No more than 45 hours of course work in the major department will be counted toward the degree.

*Only two of these courses will fulfill English major requirements. Of these two courses only one may be an American literature survey and only one may be a British literature survey. The remaining two courses will count toward general electives as long as the student does not exceed the maximum of 45 hours in English/Literature courses total, excluding general education courses in the Wright State Core.

By completing the associate degree and the Ohio Transfer Module at Sinclair, students will have met the requirements for the Wright State Core. However, students will still need to complete any remaining courses required by the department within the Wright State Core. Students must also complete at least two designated Integrated Writing courses in the major at Wright State.

The English, Integrated Language Arts Education program does NOT lead to licensure. Students must complete a graduate level program, along with additional requirements, in order to be eligible for licensure.

The following additional coursework will be required to complete the English, Integrated Language Arts program at Wright State University.
