Students who complete an **A.A. degree** in Geography at Sinclair Community College may transfer into either the B.A. or the B.S. Geography program at Wright State University. Students should verify their satisfactory academic progress (SAP) requirements with the financial aid office before pursuing classes outside of their AS.

Admission Requirements to the Geography Program at Wright State

1. Cumulative GPA of 2.0,
2. Grade of "C" or better in ENG 1100 equivalency, and
3. Two additional Arts/Humanities or Social Sciences.

Additional Information

- All Liberal Arts majors at Wright State require 42 semester hours of credit at the 3000/4000 level.
- Liberal Arts majors cannot count more than 45 semester hours within the department of their major toward graduation.
- All Liberal Arts B.A. majors at Wright State require a foreign language through the 2020 level.
