Students who complete an **Associate of Arts (A.A.)** in Music at Sinclair Community College may transfer into the Bachelor of Music in Music History and Literature at Wright State University. Students should verify their satisfactory academic progress (SAP) requirements with the financial aid office before pursuing classes outside of their A.A.

Admission Requirements to the Music Program at Wright State

Students may be admitted to the School of Music only after being admitted to Wright State University and successfully completing an audition with the appropriate Music faculty. Performance time for prepared literature may be no longer than fifteen minutes. Questioning regarding choice of repertoire should be directed to the area coordinators.
